**To the Section of Environmental Analysis and to the Surface
Transportation Board:**

I strongly urge you to not approve Canadian National's proposal to make the EJ&E line a "rail superhighway." This action only relocates environmental threats to communities that have little or no infrastructure to safely co-exist with 20-plus trains per day. We have no under-or over passes to ensure critical medical care is available for critically ill or injured Barrington area residents.

As a result, patient outcomes will suffer, and mortality rates for these patients will certainly increase as a result of delayed treatment due to re-routing to other area hospitals farther away. As an office manager, in the Emergency Department at Advocate Good Shepherd Hospital, I am very concerned at how little the federal environmental impact statement analyzed access to our emergency medical facility, these communities' closest source for critical care, trauma, emergency services and the best comprehensive cardiac care in the area.

I urge the board not to approve the proposed action in its current form, without insisting on substantive mitigation and infrastructure investment, and just as importantly, who and how it will be funded and how soon it can be constructed.
