Hello Everyone:

Thanks to those of you that attended the August 3rd Meeting in Rapid City. I think the meeting went well and I am pleased that we appear to have come to a consensus about the site form issue as follows:

- STB will add archaeological/descriptive information about new features identified by tribes at stone features sites.
- STB will expand site boundaries to encompass new features identified by tribes.

- STB will state on the site form which tribes visited the site and provided additional information regarding eligibility.
- STB will include updated eligibility determinations for each site based on tribal input.
- STB will withhold information regarding the tribal/spiritual significance of the features from site forms.

I have attached meeting notes below (along with the agenda and timeline again). Please review these carefully and let me know if they do (or don't) characterize what was said. I will need your edits/comments to the notes, if any, by August 21. Also, let me know if you do not agree with the bulleted consensus points above.
