The Historic Preservation Division (HPD) has reviewed the submitted information concerning the above referenced project in Glynn County, Georgia. Our comments are offered to assist the Surface Transportation Board (STB) and CSX Transportation in complying with the provisions of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended.

Based on the information contained in the submittal, HPD finds that the railroad corridor, originally the Atlanta, Birmingham & Coast Railway, should be considered eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) under Criteria A and C for its significance in the development of Georgia in the areas of transportation and engineering. Furthermore, it is our opinion that the project as proposed will have no adverse effect to this property, as defined in 36 CFR Part 800.5(d)(1).
