**THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SHEET METAL, AIR, RAIL AND  
TRANSPORTATION WORKERS' COMMENTS REGARDING SHERWIN  
ALUMINA COMPANY'S REQUEST TO COMPEL UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD  
COMPANY TO PROVIDE COMMON CARRIER RAIL SERVICE**

The Transportation Division of the International Association of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers ("SMART-TD")<sup>1</sup> respectfully submits the following as its Comments Regarding Sherwin Alumina Company's ("Sherwin") Request to Compel Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UPRR") to Provide Common Carrier Rail Service.

**BACKGROUND**

In April and May of 2014, Sherwin contacted UPRR regarding a possible labor disruption that might occur at its plant in Gregory, Texas (Sherwin Petition at 6). UPRR informed Sherwin that using union-represented crews would not be practicable if the crews would have to cross a picket line to enter Sherwin's plant (UPRR Reply at 17-19).

On July 8, 2014, Sherwin entered into contract negotiations with its employees' representative, the United Steelworkers of America ("USW") (Sherwin at 6).

<sup>1</sup>United Transportation Union ("UTU") and the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association ("SMWIA") have merged to become the International Association of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers ("SMART"). The former UTU is now the Transportation Division of SMART.

On October 10, 2014, Sherwin’s employees rejected a final contract offer (Sherwin Petition at 8). The following day, Sherwin locked its employees out of the plant (*Id.*).

UPRR continued to service Sherwin’s facility using management employees on a temporary, but reduced basis until November 6, 2014 (UPRR Reply at 5).

Over four months later, on March 10, 2015, Sherwin petitioned the Surface Transportation Board (“STB” or “Board”) seeking an Order that would force UPRR to resume providing common carrier service across the established picket lines, to its plant in Gregory, Texas (Sherwin Petition).

On May 4, 2015, UPRR responded to Sherwin’s Petition asserting, in part, that Sherwin’s request for service during the lockout is not reasonable given the circumstances (UPRR Reply at 5).

On July 10, 2015, SMART-TD, the certified representative of employees employed by UP in the class or craft of train service employees, including Conductors, filed a Notice of Intent to Participate.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>2</sup> The Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen (“BLET”), the certified representative of employees employed by UP in the class or craft of engine service, including Engineers, also filed a Notice of Intent to Participate. On July 14, 2015, Sherwin objected to both unions involvement in this matter, asserting the unions have “no basis on which to participate in this private dispute” and “no direct interest in this proceeding that would warrant intervention” between Sherwin and UPRR. Sherwin additionally asserts that SMART-TD’s Notice of Intent to Participate is defective. The cases it relies on however, do not support its theory that SMART-TD should not be permitted to comment. *See e.g., Compare Reasonableness BNSF Railway Company Coal Dust Mitigation Tariff Provisions*, FD 35557 (STB served Dec. 16, 2011) (approving procedural schedule setting forth deadline for notice of intent to participate); *Tex. Mun. Power Agency v. The Burlington N. & Santa Fe Ry*, NOR 42056, (STB served Sept. 24, 2004) (permitting shipper’s intervention in appeal of Board decision in private rate dispute); *Canadian Pacific Railway Company, et al. – Control – Dakota Minnesota & Eastern R.R.*, FD 35081, slip op., at 2 (STB served Dec. 27, 2007) (issuing procedural schedule setting forth deadline for notices of intent to participate); *Dakota, Minnesota & E. R.R. Corp. & Cedar Am. Rail Holdings, Inc. – Control – Iowa, Chicago & E. R.R. Corp.*, FD 3417, slip.op. at 2 (STB served Nov. 27, 2002) (permitting shippers late notice of leave to intervene when participation was necessary due to failed negotiation). As demonstrated herein, SMART-TD has an interest in this dispute based on its representative status and its concern for the safety

## SMART-TD'S COMMENTS

Section 11101(a) of the Interstate Commerce Commission Termination Act of 1995 provides, in pertinent part, that a “rail carrier providing transportation or service subject to the jurisdiction of the Board under this part shall provide the transportation or service on reasonable request. 49 U.S.C. § 11101(a) (emphasis added). Indeed, it has long been held that the obligation of carriers to provide service upon request is “not absolute,” but is “subject to reasonable limitations and conditions.” *Montgomery Ward & Co., Inc., v. Consolidated Freightways*, 42 M.C.C. 225, 231 (1943). A reasonable request for service depends on the facts and circumstances of the specific request. *Montana v. BNSF Ry.*, NOR 42124, slip op. at 7 (STB served Apr., 26, 2013). When circumstances arise that are beyond the carrier’s control, the carriers have the right to responsibly evaluate whether the shippers demand for service is a reasonable request. *Meier & Pohlmann Furniture Co. v. Gibbons*, 233 F.2d 296, 304 (8th Cir. 1956); *see also Louisiana Grocers Co-Operative v. Ill. C.G.R.*, 353 I.C.C. 606, 609 (1977). While carriers are required to provide service on reasonable request, “an employer is not required to subject his employees to risks of injury or harm.” *Meier*, 233 F.2d at 304.

As evidenced by UPRR’s Reply brief and the supporting verified statements, UPRR reasonably evaluated Sherwin’s requests in light of the facts and circumstances in this case and concluded that Sherwin’s request was not reasonable. UPRR expressed its concerns and position with respect to having union-represented employees serve Sherwin during an active picket line, advised that management personnel could only serve Sherwin for a limited period before “impairing [its] ability to safely and efficiently serve other customers,” and discussed several

of its members. Should Sherwin succeed in its attempt to have the Board order UPRR to provide common carrier service, such could potentially place SMART-TD-represented conductors and/or train service members in a vulnerable and potentially dangerous situation.

alternatives with Sherwin, including transloading (UPRR Reply at 3). Despite UPRR's advance notice and Sherwin being fully aware that UPRR was not going to require its unionized employees to cross the picket lines, Sherwin, acting at its own peril, made the decision to and has continued to lock out its employees. Such should not be rewarded by forcing UP to perform absolute service to Sherwin's facility. Now, Sherwin wants to embroil UPRR and UPRR's union-represented employees into its labor dispute with USW.

While there may not have been any threats and/or violence on the picket line thus far, to date, no union-represented crews have crossed the picket lines. Picket-line threats and violence have been held to violate the Federal Rail Safety Act ("FRSA"). *See, e.g., Monongahela Ry. v. Transp. Comm'n Union*, 132 LRRM 2180, 1989 WL 121170 at \*5 (W.D.Pa. 1989) (finding employees' fears of danger if they returned to work were well-founded "due to the lawless conduct of strangers and non-employees."); *see also Colorado & Wyoming and United Transp. Union*, SBA, FRSA Dispute (Richard R. Kasher Nov. 30, 2000) (finding members refusal to cross USW picket line protected under FRSA). To perform switching at Sherwin's facility, SMART-TD-represented Conductors have to exit the train, walk across a four lane highway to remove a derail in order to serve the Sherwin plant (UPRR Reply at 7). This places the Conductors on the ground, unprotected and in close proximity from the individuals picketing the plant (*Id.*). Sherwin obviously had some safety concerns itself. Indeed, Sherwin admits that it "arranged for sheriff's deputies to be present outside of the plant to ensure that no traffic issues or other problems occur" and "enlisted a specialized private security company to man external [twenty-four hour] checkpoints in the vicinity of the plant" (Sherwin Petition at 8).

Further, Gregory, Texas is a small community with a population of just under 2,000 (Exhibit 1). SMART-TD members may frequent the same stores, gas stations, restaurants and

religious institutions as do the locked-out Sherwin employees. Their children may attend the same schools and play on the same sports teams. Any protection provided by the sheriff's deputies and the private security officers would be limited to the plant, and would not protect TD-members from reprisals they might encounter while off duty on personal time.

### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the foregoing and the extensive briefing exchanged to date, it is clear that UPRR should not be required to provide service where Sherwin has created the conditions which make the common carrier's obligation impracticable and where UPRR's refusal to provide service is reasonable based on the facts and circumstances involved.








