
Re: Petition of the Western Coal Traffic League, EP 664 (Sub-No. 2)
Railroad Revenue Adequacy, EP 722

Dear Ms. Brown:

On May 12, 2014, the Association of American Railroads ("AAR") filed a motion to modify the procedural schedules in the two proceedings captioned above.

The Western Coal Traffic League ("WCTL") neither supports nor opposes the AAR's motion. However, if the AAR's motion is granted, WCTL strongly requests that the Board hold a separate public hearing in EP 664 (Sub-No. 2) promptly after reply comments are filed in that proceeding, so that the cost of capital proceeding will not be delayed by the revenue adequacy proceeding. *See* AAR Motion at 6. AAR counsel has authorized WCTL counsel to state that the AAR neither supports nor opposes WCTL's request.
