This is in response to your request that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers issue a letter of no objection for the above-referenced activity. The subject project has been assigned number LRC-2015-786. Please reference this number in all future correspondence concerning this project.

Following a review of the information you furnished to this office and assuming your project is conducted only as set forth in the information provided, this office has determined that the subject property does not require a Department of the Army (DA) permit to complete the proposed work. Please be aware that any unpermitted discharge into an area within the jurisdiction of this office may result in civil or criminal enforcement under the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. Sec. 1319.

This determination is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of this letter and covers only your project as depicted in your submittal entitled "STB Docket No. AB 6 (Sub-No. 493X) – BNSF Railway Company – Abandonment Exemption – in Cook County, Illinois" dated March 3, 2016, prepared by Karl Morell & Assoc. Please note that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers does not have jurisdiction over impacts to regulated flood plains and can not, as requested, certify that this project does not impact any regulated flood plain. This determination only covers Sec. 404 of the Clean Water Act and Sec. 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act.

Soil erosion and sediment controls (SESC) measures shall be implemented at the project site and properly maintained throughout construction of the project. Proper installation and regular maintenance of SESC measures will prevent construction materials from entering downstream locations.

It is your responsibility to obtain any required state, county, or local approvals for impacts to wetland areas not under the Department of the Army jurisdiction. For projects located in unincorporated and unauthorized municipalities in Cook County, please contact the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago at (312) 751-3247. For projects in incorporated areas of Cook County, contact the authorized municipality for information related to the Watershed Management Ordinance.

This determination is based only on the proposed activity and is not an approved jurisdiction determination for the subject parcel.
