



New England Transrail’s Response to The Board’s March 1, 2016 Decision


On March 1, 2016, the Board issued a Decision focusing on quality-controlling the service list for this Docket. The Board directed that anyone who filed comments on the Board’s December 14, 2015 Decision must (1) serve anyone listed as a Party of Record on the list attached to the March 1 Decision who had not previously been served, and (2) certify that such service has taken place.

New England Transrail (“NET”) did not comment on the December 14 Decision, though NET did comment on requests for an extension to the comment deadline filed by two other parties. In an exercise of caution, and to help refine the service list, NET states as follows:

- NET certifies that it has now served any Party of Record not previously served with a copy of its December 28, 2015 Response to Requests for Extension; and
- Non-parties Jeffrey Bauer, J. Patrick Berry, and Kirk Van Tine are no longer active members of Baker Botts and can be deleted from the service list.
