Motion for Partial Withdrawal of Exemption Authority (Errata)

Dear Ms. Brown:

On September 10, 2013, I filed a motion for partial withdrawal of exemption authority in the above-captioned proceeding on behalf of The Alabama Great Southern Railroad Company (“AGS”). The final sentence of that motion states as follows:

NSR [Norfolk Southern Railway Company, AGS’ corporate parent] acknowledges that, should it later elect to abandon the Line or any part of it, NSR will need to seek appropriate authority under a new proceeding, subject also to the then-applicable environmental review process.

That statement is in error, inasmuch as the subject acknowledgement should have been attributed to AGS as the carrier owning the subject rail line, not NSR. The concluding statement in the subject motion should read as follows:

AGS acknowledges that, should it later elect to abandon the Line or any part of it, AGS will need to seek appropriate authority under a new proceeding, subject also to the then-applicable environmental review process.
