As the Board is aware, on May 9, 2016, Pan Am Southern LLC ("PAS") withdrew its outstanding motions to compel discovery. Since that time, the parties, PAS and New England Central Railroad, Inc. (collectively, "Party" or "Parties") have resolved their remaining outstanding discovery disputes, with each Party preserving its right to raise objections and claims of relevancy with respect to any document produced or argument raised in the proceeding.

Due to the discovery disputes, the procedural schedule was held in abeyance. Given that the Parties have now conferred and resolved the remaining discovery disputes, the Parties jointly propose the resumption of the procedural schedule as follows:

PAS Reply Evidence and Argument	July 19, 2016
NECR Service of Discovery	August 16, 2016
PAS Discovery Responses	September 13, 2016
NECR motions to compel, if necessary	October 11, 2016
NECR Rebuttal Evidence and Argument	60 days from when any discovery disputes have been resolved, and both Parties have confirmed that discovery is complete.

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PAS Surrebuttal Evidence and Argument 30 days from filing of NECR
Rebuttal Evidence and Argument
