Dear Ms. Brown:

By letter dated April 9, 2015, Ironwood, LLC and Steelway Realty Corporation (“Ironwood/Steelway”) have submitted a copy of a Decision and Order of Judge Suddaby of the Northern District of New York issued on March 26, 2015.

While JGB Properties, LLC (“JGB”) does not oppose the filing of this decision in the docket for notice purposes, JGB does take issue with Ironwood/Steelway’s misleading characterization of the Decision and its findings. The Decision speaks for itself.

Moreover, to be clear, as part of its Decision, the Court did not take issue with or dispute the Board’s jurisdiction over the subject rail line, or its authority to issue a declaratory order as requested and described in JGB’s Petition. It also found that “a judicial remedy appears available” to JGB should it prevail at the STB, and in the absence of the issuance of a court-ordered preliminary injunction. Decision at 15 n.6.
