
CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) responds to the letter filed by the Marion County Commission (“Marion”) on May 22, 2014, seeking an extension of time to negotiate interim trail use/rail banking.

CSXT agrees to the 180-day extension of time until November 20, 2014 to negotiate interim trail use/rail banking with Marion for the 17.51-mile rail line on its Southern Region, Huntington Division East, Fairmont Subdivision, between Barrackville, milepost BS-306.32, and Mannington, milepost BS-319.48, including the Dents Run Spur between milepost BSB 0.00 and milepost BSB 4.35, in Marion County, WV.

As provided in 49 CFR 1152.29(e)(2), the extension of the trail negotiation period until November 20, 2014, creates a regulatory barrier to consummation of the abandonment, which provides CSXT with an additional 60 days to consummate the abandonment to January 19, 2015, if trail negotiation is unsuccessful. CSXT respectfully requests that the Board confirm that the extension of the consummation period as provided in the regulations applies in this instance.
