On December 24, 2014, Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“NSR”) filed a verified notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. pt. 1152 subpart F—Exempt Abandonments for NSR to abandon approximately 1.60 miles of rail line (referred to herein as the “Line”) located in Erie County, New York, extending from milepost VK 3.90 (near Scrivner Drive) to milepost VK 5.50 (near Indian Church Road). Notice of the exemption was served on January 13, 2015, and published in the Federal Register on January 16, 2015 (80 Fed. Reg. 2,481).

NSR has complied with the conditions imposed by the Board in its January 13th decision as modified by the Board’s subsequent February 11, 2015 decision (“Feb. 11th Decision”).
