Dear Ms. Brown:

Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“NSR”) hereby requests a one-year extension, until September 17, 2017, of the abandonment authority granted to NSR in the above-captioned proceeding. Currently, NSR’s abandonment authority expires on September 17, 2016, per the Board’s decision served September 17, 2015. Despite NSR’s efforts, salvage will not be able to be complete by the current deadline because NSR is actively attempting to resolve salvaging conditions imposed by the Board in a subsequent decision served on October 16, 2015 (“Oct. 16th Decision”).¹

Over the past year, NSR has worked towards consummating its abandonment authority in this proceeding. However, due to various reasons, NSR has been unable to complete the consultation and salvage process. As such, NSR needs additional time to complete the


¹ The conditions imposed by the Board include the following: (1) consult with NGS and notify NGS at least 90 days prior to beginning salvage activities that will disturb or destroy any geodetic station markers; and (2) prior to commencement of any salvage activities (i) consult with FWS regarding potential impacts from salvaging activities to federally listed threatened and endangered species that may occur in the vicinity of the line, and (ii) report the results of the consultations in writing to the Board’s Office of Environmental Analysis prior to the onset of salvage operations.
