





RE: Docket AB-33 (sub-No 140) Union Pacific Railroad Company Abandonment and Discontinuance of Operation from M.P. 66 near Jamaica, Nebraska, to M.P. 125 near Marietta, Kansas – in Lancaster and Gage Counties in Nebraska and Marshall County in Kansas. Also Docket AB-33 (sub-No 208X) Abandonment and Discontinuance of Operation from M.P. 125 near Marietta, Kansas, to M.P. 133.13 near Marysville, Kansas. See attached maps.

Dear Ms. Brown:

Nebraska Trails Foundation (NTF) purchased Docket AB-33 (sub-No 140) from Union Pacific Railroad Company in February, 2002, and then purchased Docket AB-33 (sub-No 208X) from Union Pacific Railroad Company in November 2005.

Then, also in November 2005, NTF transferred the title to the right-of-way from the Nebraska State Line M.P. 121.25 to M.P. 133.13 near Marysville, Kansas, to Marshall County Connection, Inc., a non-profit 501(c)-3 foundation. The Marshall County Connection then proceeded to develop the trail. Development of eight of the 11.88 miles of the trails have now been completed.

Nebraska Trails Foundation, Inc., failed to notify the STB of this transfer of ownership at that time, and now request that STB now make this transfer of ownership.

STATEMENT OF WILLINGNESS TO ASSURE FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

In order to establish interim trail use and rail-banking under Section 8(d) of the National Trails System Act, 16 U.S.C. 1247(d) and 49 C.F.R. 1152.29, Nebraska Trails Foundation, Inc., and Marshall County Connection, Inc., are willing to assume full responsibility for management of, for any legal liability arising out of the transfer or use of (unless the use is immune from liability, in which case it need only indemnify the railroad against any potential liability), and for the payment of any and all taxes that may be levied or assessed against the right-of-way owned by the Union Pacific Railroad.




