
Some of the information sought from Grenada Railway, LLC by the Board's
Decision, served September 10, 2013, cannot be filed even under seal, subject to a
Protective Order, without the risk of prosecution pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 11904.

For example, paragraph A asks for the listing of each shipper served by the
GRYR and the number carloads originated and terminated each year from 2009 to the
present. The shippers, however, may not want it known by their competitors or their
customers the volume of business they have been doing and whether it is increasing or
declining.

Similarly, paragraph J asks for the name of the shipper or consignee of each car
handled by GRYR for a customer located at Canton, Goodman, West, Vaughan, Durant
and Pickens between June 2011 and the present. That may be highly confidential and
proprietary information the disclosure of which is prohibited by the statute.

Please advise how GRYR can make that information available to the Board
without incurring the risk of prosecution by making it available to others.
