This MEMORANDUM OF SECURITY AGREEMENT (this "Memorandum") dated as of June 10, 2015 is between INTERNATIONAL BANK OF COMMERCE, a Texas state banking corporation, as Secured Party, and SOUTH TEXAS LOCOMOTIVE SERVICE, LLC, a Texas limited liability company, as Debtor.

The parties to this Memorandum hereby acknowledge and confirm the following:

A. Debtor and Secured Party have entered into that certain Security Agreement, dated on or about the date hereof (as amended, amended and restated, modified or otherwise in effect from time to time, collectively, the "Security Agreement") pursuant to which, among other things, Debtor has granted to Secured Party a first priority security interest in certain locomotives identified on Exhibit "A," attached hereto (collectively, the "Equipment") and all leases, use agreements and other agreements in connection with and related to the Equipment identified on Exhibit "A."




