
Dear Ms. Brown,

This request is filed on behalf of the City of Lafayette, which is a municipality interested in transportation and recreation, hereinafter referred to as "proponent". The proponent remains engaged in discussions with Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway ("BNSF") toward the desired outcome for all parties, which is an agreement regarding railbanking and interim trail use of the line by the proponent.

On October 26, 2011 the STB granted the proponent's request to impose a public use condition to allow for negotiating the railbanking of the line for trail use expiring April 23, 2012. The proponent hereby requests an additional 60-day period in which to continue negotiations with BNSF. BNSF is amenable to this extension and continued negotiations.
