
Dear Ms. Brown:

Wisconsin Central Ltd. ("WCL") requests an additional 60-day extension, to September 13, 2016, to file a reply as previously directed by the Board in the above-captioned proceeding. WCL and the City of Appleton (the "City") have been negotiating an arrangement that would resolve the matters raised by the City's pending declaratory order petition, and agreement on final terms is pending. That agreement will require governmental approval after requisite public hearing. The requested extension would provide the parties time to complete these arrangements and, in turn, allow voluntary dismissal of this proceeding.
