By complaint filed March 11, 1998, Northern Indiana Public Service Company (NIPSC) requests that the Board order Consolidated Rail Corporation (Conrail) to establish a “reasonable rail rate” for the movement of coal in unit trains from Conrail’s interchange with the Union Pacific Railroad Company at Momence, IL, to NIPSC’s generating plant near Wheatfield, IN.

By motion filed on November 20, 1998, NIPSC states that the parties jointly seek an additional extension of time, until December 18, 1998, to file proposed procedural schedules under 49 CFR 1111.9(a).<sup>1</sup>

The motion for an additional extension will be granted.

It is ordered:

1. The proposed procedural schedule(s) is (are) due by December 18, 1998.
