On November 22, 2006, Williams Olefins, L.L.C. (Williams) filed a rate complaint against Grand Trunk Corporation (GTC) under 49 U.S.C. 10701(d)(1). By decision served December 11, 2006, the Board held the procedural schedule in this proceeding in abeyance for a period of 30 days to permit mediation of the dispute pursuant to 49 CFR 1109.1. On January 11, 2007, GTC filed a request that the Board continue to hold the procedural schedule in abeyance through January 31, 2007, to provide the parties with time to document the agreement they have reached in mediation. GTC states that it has been authorized to represent to the Board that Williams consents to GTC's continuation request.

The request to continue to hold the procedural schedule in abeyance until January 31, 2007, will be granted.

It is ordered:

1. The procedural schedule is held in abeyance until January 31, 2007.
