CSX TRANSPORTATION, INC.—ADVERSE ABANDONMENT—
IN SHELBY COUNTY, TN

Decided: June 20, 2007

On May 26, 2007, Memphis Community Connector (MCC) filed a petition for waivers and exemption pertaining to the Board's abandonment application procedures. In the petition, MCC mistakenly named CSX Corporation (CSXC) in the caption, rather than its subsidiary, CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSXT), which is the owner of the line at issue. To clarify the record, MCC requests that the caption be corrected to substitute CSXT for CSXC, so that the caption is consistent with the text of the petition and the party actually served.

The request is reasonable. The caption in this docket has been corrected to substitute "CSX Transportation, Inc." for "CSX Corporation," as reflected in this decision. Accordingly, CSXC's motion to dismiss and the relief sought therein are moot. However, because there appears to have been some confusion caused by MCC's error, the due date for CSXT and interested persons to file replies to MCC's petition will be extended until 5 days after the service date of this decision.

It is ordered:

1. CSXC's motion to dismiss is dismissed as moot.
2. The due date for replies to the petition for waivers and exemption is extended until June 26, 2007.
3. This decision is effective on its service date.
