DYNO NOBEL, INC.

v.

KANEB PIPE LINE PARTNERS, L.P.

Decided: March 29, 2006

On June 16, 2003, Dyno Nobel Inc. (Dyno) filed a complaint with the Board challenging rate increases of Kaneb Pipe Line Partners, L.P. (Kaneb) for the pipeline transportation of anhydrous ammonia.

Dyno filed a motion to dismiss its complaint on March 24, 2006. Dyno states that it has entered into a confidential settlement agreement with Kaneb, effective as of March 20, 2006, which resolves the dispute. Accordingly, Dyno requests that its claims be dismissed with prejudice.

Dyno's motion to dismiss is reasonable and will be granted. Also, because the dismissal renders moot an August 1, 2003 petition to intervene in this proceeding filed by CF Industries, Inc. (CFI), that petition will be denied.

It is ordered:

1. Dyno's June 16, 2003 complaint is dismissed with prejudice.
2. CFI's motion to intervene is denied.
3. This decision is effective on its date of service.
