By motion filed on January 6, 2003, Consolidated Rail Corporation, CSX Corporation, and CSX Transportation, Inc., jointly request a 7-day extension of time, from January 6, 2003, to January 13, 2003, to file a reply to the petition of the City of New York (the City) to late-file an application for a Certificate of Interim Trail Use (CITU) and to the City’s application for a CITU.
