STB Ex Parte No. 656 (Sub-No. 1)

INVESTIGATION INTO THE PRACTICES OF THE NATIONAL CLASSIFICATION
COMMITTEE

Decided: November 4, 2005

By motion filed on November 1, 2005, the National Small Shipments Traffic Conference (NASSTRAC) requests a 14-day extension, from November 18, 2005, to December 2, 2005, of the deadline for filing opening comments in this proceeding. See the Board's decision served on October 13, 2005, and the notice published in the Federal Register on October 19, 2005, at 70 FR 60881-82. NASSTRAC maintains that the request is justified because of scheduling conflicts. According to NASSTRAC, the National Classification Committee (NCC) takes no position on the requested extension. The requested extension appears to be reasonable and will be granted. A corresponding extension of the deadline, from December 8, 2005, to December 22, 2005, will be granted for submission of NCC's reply comments.

It is ordered:

1. The deadline for filing opening comments in this proceeding is extended to December 2, 2005, and the deadline for filing NCC's reply is extended to December 22, 2005.
2. Notice of this decision will be published in the Federal Register.
