PACIFIC UNIFIED RAILROAD CORPORATION—OPERATION EXEMPTION—KAISER
EAGLE MOUNTAIN RAILROAD

Decided: December 4, 2007

On November 16, 2007, Pacific Unified Railroad Corporation (PURC) filed a verified notice of exemption to obtain non-exclusive trackage rights from Kaiser Eagle Mountain Railroad over approximately 52 miles of right-of-way between milepost 52.0 in Eagle Mountain and milepost 0.0 at Ferrum Junction, in Riverside County, CA.

On November 23, 2007, PURC filed a letter to withdraw its verified notice of exemption because it states that it needed to file a different type of exemption notice instead. The request to withdraw the notice of exemption will be granted.¹

This action will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or the conservation of energy resources.

It is ordered:

1. PURC's request to withdraw its notice of trackage rights exemption is granted.
2. This decision is effective on its service date.
