Decided: March 29, 2004

As indicated in Decision No. 13 (served March 3, 2004), a public hearing respecting the three “shared assets areas” that were created in connection with the Conrail Transaction will be held on Friday, April 2, 2004. The public hearing will begin at 12:00 noon in Ceremonial Courtroom #2 (rather than in Courtroom #1) on the Third Floor of the Clarkson S. Fisher Federal Building & Courthouse, at 402 East State Street in Trenton, NJ. All the other details noted in Decision No. 13 remain the same.

In Decision No. 12 (served February 12, 2004, and published in the Federal Register on February 18, 2004, at 69 FR 7664), any person wishing to speak at the April 2nd hearing was instructed to file with the Board, as soon as possible but no later than March 18, 2004, a written notice of intent to speak, along with a requested time allotment. Such notices of intent to speak have now been filed.

The Board is now issuing this decision to set a schedule for the April 2nd hearing. The schedule of appearances and the time provided for each person speaking at the hearing appear in the Appendix to this decision.

This action will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or the conservation of energy resources.

It is ordered:

1. Time at the April 2nd public hearing is allotted as reflected in the Appendix to this decision. Conrail Inc. and Consolidated Rail Corporation (collectively Conrail), CSX Corporation and CSX Transportation, Inc. (collectively CSX), and Norfolk Southern Corporation and Norfolk Southern

Railway Company (collectively NS) may reserve part of its time to address at the end of the hearing any concerns that may be raised.

2. This decision is effective on the date of service.
