v.  
CONSOLIDATED RAIL CORPORATION

By complaint filed March 11, 1998, Northern Indiana Public Service Company (NIPSC) requests that the Board order Consolidated Rail Corporation (Conrail) to establish a "reasonable rail rate" for the movement of coal in unit trains from the point of Conrail's interchange with the Union Pacific Railroad Company at Momence, IL, to NIPSC's generating plant near Wheatfield, IN.

By motion filed on July 29, 1998, Conrail states that the parties jointly seek an additional extension of time, until September 15, 1998, to file a proposed procedural schedule or schedules under 49 CFR 1111.9(a).<sup>1</sup>

The motion for an additional extension will be granted.

It is ordered:

1. The proposed procedural schedule or schedules are due by September 15, 1998.
2. This decision is effective on its date of service.
