THE SHOPS AT KINGSBURY SQUARE, LLC—ADVERSE ABANDONMENT—CHICAGO
TERMINAL RAILROAD IN CHICAGO, IL

Decided: May 21, 2007

On May 2, 2007, The Shops at Kingsbury Square, LLC (Kingsbury Square) filed a petition for partial waiver of abandonment regulations and for exemptions, in conjunction with an application that Kingsbury Square intends to file for adverse abandonment of the authority of Chicago Terminal Railroad (CTR) to operate over a segment of rail line between the north edge of North Avenue and the terminus of the line near the intersection of Division and Halsted Streets, a distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in Chicago, Cook County, IL.

By a request filed on May 18, 2007, CTR seeks an extension of the May 22, 2007 deadline for filing a reply to Kingsbury Square's petition. Specifically, CTR requests that the due date be extended by 20 days, to June 11, 2007.

CTR states that the parties are negotiating a resolution to the matter and are optimistic as to the possibility of reaching a settlement acceptable to all. CTR also states that counsel for Kingsbury Square has advised CTR that he has no objection to the extension request.

CTR's request for an extension of the due date for filing its reply, to June 11, 2007, is reasonable and will be granted as set forth below.

It is ordered:

1. CTR's reply to Kingsbury Square's petition for partial waiver and exemptions is due on June 11, 2007.
2. This decision is effective on the date of its service.
