On May 27, 2016, pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1104.7(b), Union Tank Car Company, GATX Corporation, Trinity Industries, Inc., and American Railcar Industries, Inc., each of whom is associated with the North American Freight Car Association (NAFCA, and collectively referred to as the NAFCA Member Companies) requested that the Board extend the due date for the filing of replies to Union Pacific Railroad Company's (UP) Petition for Subpoenas (Petition) by 14 days from June 6, 2016 to June 20, 2016 (Motion for Extension). The NAFCA Member Companies represent that they are authorized to report that UP and Complainants do not object to the Board's extension of the due date for the NAFCA Member Companies replies to June 20, 2016. Additionally, the NAFCA Member Companies requested expedited action on the Motion for Extension.

For good cause shown, the Motion for Extension is granted. Replies to the Petition are due on or before June 20, 2016.
