NAPA VALLEY WINE TRAIN, INC.–ADVERSE ABANDONMENT–  
IN NAPA VALLEY, CA.

Decided: July 9, 2001

On April 6, 2001, the Napa Valley Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) filed an adverse application under 49 U.S.C. 10903 requesting that the Surface Transportation Board authorize the abandonment by the Napa Valley Wine Train, Inc. (NVWT) of segments of NVWT's line located between milepost 67.50 and milepost 68.62, milepost 68.73 and milepost 69.33, and milepost 69.44 and milepost 70.00, in Napa County, CA. Notice of the application was served and published in the Federal Register on April 26, 2001 (66 FR 21039).

On June 21, 2001, the District filed a motion to dismiss the application without prejudice. The District states that it has reached agreements with NVWT, which have been approved by the Napa County Flood Control Board, and, accordingly, there is no need to proceed with its application. The motion will be granted, and the proceeding will be discontinued.

This action will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or the conservation of energy resources.

It is ordered:

1. The District's motion to dismiss this proceeding without prejudice is granted.
2. This proceeding is discontinued.
3. This decision is effective on the date of service.
