DYNO NOBEL INC.

v.

KANEB PIPE LINE PARTNERS, L.P.

Decided: June 30, 2003

On June 16, 2003, Dyno Noble Inc. (Dyno) filed with the Board a complaint against Kaneb Pipe Line Partners, L.P. (Kaneb), challenging certain rate increases with respect to shipments of anhydrous ammonia.

By a motion filed on June 26, 2003, Kaneb requests an extension, until August 1, 2003, of the deadline for filing its answer to Dyno's complaint. In support of its extension request, Kaneb states that its president, who has specific knowledge of the subject matter of the complaint, will be out of the country for several weeks and that Kaneb will need the additional time to conduct a thorough investigation of the allegations contained in the complaint. Kaneb advises that Dyno has agreed to the proposed extension.

The request for an extension of the deadline by which Kaneb must file its answer to Dyno's complaint is reasonable, and will, therefore, be granted.

This action will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or the conservation of energy resources.

It is ordered:

1. The deadline by which Kaneb must file its answer to Dyno's complaint is extended to August 1, 2003.

2. This decision is effective on the service date.
