

CHAPTER 6 DISTRIBUTION OF FINAL EIS

The Board's regulations identify the types of agencies and officials to receive the environmental documentation (49 CFR Part 1105.7). Additionally, CEQ regulations identify appropriate distribution (40 CFR Part 1500 to 1508).
