USX CORPORATION—CONTROL EXEMPTION—TRANSTAR, INC.

(Arbitration Review)

Decided: March 21, 2002

By motion filed on March 19, 2002, and supplemented on March 20, 2002, Tracks Traffic and Management Services, Inc. (TTMS) requests an extension, until April 9, 2002, to file a petition for review of an arbitration award issued on February 28, 2002.

Under the Board's rules, an appeal must be filed within 20 days of an arbitration decision unless a later date is authorized pursuant to 49 CFR 1115.8. The due date for filing an appeal was March 20, 2002. Counsel for TTMS states that it was newly retained and needs additional time to prepare a petition for review. Counsel also represents that the other party in the arbitration, the Transportation Communications International Union, does not oppose the requested extension.

The request is reasonable and will be granted.

It is ordered:

1. The deadline for TTMS to file its appeal is extended to April 9, 2002.
2. This decision is effective on its service date.
