This proceeding arises out of the efforts of St. Johnsbury Trucking Company, Inc. (respondent) to collect undercharges on certain shipments from shipper, Philips Electronics N/A; Philips Lighting Co. Division (petitioner). The matter is before the Board on referral from the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.

By decision served July 9, 1996, a procedural schedule was established in this proceeding. Petitioner's opening statement was due on September 9, 1996. However, Board records indicate that petitioner has not filed its statement. It is ordered:

1. Petitioner is directed within 20 days of service of this decision to file its opening statement or to show cause why this proceeding should not be dismissed.

2. If petitioner files its opening statement, respondent's reply statement will be due 30 days from petitioner's opening statement, and petitioner's rebuttal statement will be due 20 days from the date of respondent files its reply.

3. This decision is effective on the service date.
