Decided: November 25, 2003

By decision served on November 21, 2003, the Board extended to December 11, 2003, the deadline for Canadian National Railway Company (CN) and Fraser Papers, Inc. (Fraser) to file protests to the application for adverse discontinuance and abandonment filed by the Trustee of the estate of the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company (the Trustee).

By motion filed on November 25, 2003, the Trustee asks the Board to clarify that its decision extending the deadline applies to the filing of all comments and protests, not just those of CN and Fraser.

The Trustee's motion for clarification will be granted. The deadline of December 11, 2003, will apply to the filing of all comments and protests to the Trustee's application in these unusual proceedings.

It is ordered:

1. The deadline for the submission of protests and comments is extended to December 11, 2003.

2. This decision is effective on its date of service.
