LAKE STATE RAILWAY COMPANY--ABANDONMENT
EXEMPTION--IN ALPENA COUNTY, MI

Decided: May 11, 2000

On November 18, 1997, a decision and notice of interim trail use or abandonment (NITU) was served, authorizing a 180-day period for the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) to negotiate an interim trail use/rail banking agreement with Lake State Railway Company (Lake State) for an 8-mile line of railroad between milepost 0.0 near Alpena, and milepost 8.0 near Hillman, in Alpena County, MI.¹ Extensions of the negotiation period were granted by decisions served May 15, 1998, November 19, 1998, May 13, 1999, and November 5, 1999. The negotiating period was scheduled to expire on May 4, 2000.

On May 8, 2000, MDNR and Lake State each filed a request to extend the negotiation period for an additional 180 days. The parties state that they are continuing negotiations towards an agreement and expect to complete an agreement within 180 days.

Where, as here, the carrier has not consummated the abandonment at the end of the previously imposed negotiating period and is willing to continue trail use negotiations, the Board retains jurisdiction and the NITU negotiating period may be extended.² Under the circumstances, further extension of the negotiating period is warranted. See Birt v. STB, 90 F.3d 580, 588-90 (D.C. Cir. 1996); Grantwood Village v. Missouri Pac. R.R. Co., 95 F.3d 654, 659 (8th Cir. 1996), cert. denied, 519 U.S. 1149 (1997). Accordingly, the NITU negotiating period will be extended for an additional 180 days from May 4, 2000.

This decision will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or the conservation of energy resources.
