By motion filed March 11, 1999, complainants¹ have moved to dismiss with prejudice the complaint filed in this proceeding on December 24, 1995, as respects defendant CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX, the originating railroad for the relevant traffic) and all other remaining defendants.² The motion will be granted.

This action will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or the conservation of energy resources.

It is ordered:

1. The motion to dismiss is granted. The complaint in this proceeding is dismissed with prejudice, and the proceeding is discontinued.
2. This decision is effective on its date of service.
