PCI TRANSPORTATION, INC.

v.

FORT WORTH & WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY

Decided: December 11, 2006

On October 26, 2006, PCI Transportation, Inc. (PCI), filed a complaint and application for injunctive relief against Fort Worth & Western Railroad Company (FWWR). At FWWR's request, the time for it to file an answer to PCI's complaint was extended to November 27, 2006, in a decision served on November 20, 2006. FWWR filed a motion to dismiss PCI's complaint on November 24, 2006.

On December 7, 2006, PCI filed a stipulated motion for an extension of time, to December 22, 2006, to file a reply to FWWR's motion to dismiss. FWWR consents to the extension request.¹

The request is reasonable. PCI's request to extend the time to file a reply to FWWR's motion to dismiss will be granted.

It is ordered:

1. The time for PCI to file a reply to FWWR's motion to dismiss is extended to December 22, 2006.

2. This decision is effective on its date of service.
