v.

CONSOLIDATED RAIL CORPORATION, CSX TRANSPORTATION, INC., AND
NORFOLK SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

In its decision served September 29, 1995, giving notice of the amended complaint, the Board's predecessor agency, the Interstate Commerce Commission, named Norfolk Southern Corporation, the party actually named in the amended complaint filed on September 20, 1995, as a defendant in the decision's caption. The Board is withdrawing Norfolk Southern Corporation (NSC) as a defendant and substituting the Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS) as the proper defendant. NS is a wholly owned railroad operating subsidiary of NSC.

It is ordered:

1. Norfolk Southern Railway Company is substituted for the Norfolk Southern Corporation as a defendant.

2. This decision is effective on its date of service.
