APPLICATION OF VENTURA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
FOR AN ORDER REQUIRING JOINT USE OF TERMINAL FACILITIES
IN VENTURA COUNTY, CA

Decided: September 9, 1998

On September 1, 1998, the Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) filed a notice of withdrawal of its application filed February 12, 1998, in which VCTC sought an order under 49 U.S.C. 11102(a) to require Union Pacific Railroad Company (UP) to permit VCTC to use certain of its terminal facilities and 18.6 miles of main line trackage for commuter rail operations, operated for VCTC by the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRR). VCTC states that it has reached an agreement with UP that permits continued use of the line segment at issue in this proceeding for commuter rail service by VCTC and SCRR. Accordingly, VCTC will be permitted to withdraw its application and this proceeding will be discontinued.

It is ordered:

1. VCTC is permitted to withdraw its application and the proceeding is discontinued.
2. This decision will be effective on its date of service.
