PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

v.

CONSOLIDATED RAIL CORPORATION, ET AL.

By motion filed on May 7, 1999, complainant PP&L, Inc. (PP&L), formerly known as Pennsylvania Power & Light Company, states that it has reached a voluntary settlement with the defendant railroads (Consolidated Rail Corporation, CSX Transportation, Inc., and Norfolk Southern Railway Company) of the disputed matters that remain pending in the complaint proceeding. Accordingly, PP&L requests that its complaint be dismissed. PP&L advises that all of the defendant railroads support this motion. PP&L's motion is reasonable and will be granted.

It is ordered:

1. PP&L's complaint is dismissed and the proceeding is discontinued.
2. This decision is effective on its date of service.
