Re: **STB Docket No. AB-1097 X-** Pickens Railway Company- Abandonment Exemption- in Pickens County. SC

Dear Ms. Brown:

The City of Easley, South Carolina, and the City of Pickens, South Carolina (collectively, the "Cities") on September 27, 2012, filed with the Surface Transportation Board ("STB") a joint request for the issuance of a Public Use Condition and Interim Trail Use Condition and Statement of Willingness to Assume Financial Responsibility ("Requests") in connection with the rail line which is the subject of the above abandonment petition.

The STB on October 26, 2012, issued its Decision and Notice of Interim Trail Use or Abandonment wherein, *inter alia*, it issued a Notice of Interim Trail Use ("NITU") for the subject rail line and granted the parties a period of 180 days to negotiate a sale of the rail line to the Cities. This 180 day period will expire April 24, 2012.

The Cities and Pickens Railway Company have made progress in negotiations regarding a sale of the subject rail line to the Cities, but the parties require additional time to continue and hopefully complete those negotiations. Therefore, the Cities, with the consent of Pickens Railway Company, jointly request that the STB extend the parties' negotiation period for an additional period of 180 days.


NITU extended to 10/21/13




