Dave - The L&I's right-of-way is generally 30 feet on either side of the center line, for a total of 60-feet. In negotiating the easement with L&I we were told the line is generally 60-feet wide and that is what is being acquired in the easement and is so stated in the easement agreement that was filed with the Board. There are outlying parcels and yards that are not included in the transaction, and there are some places where the right-of-way may be a couple of feet less than 60. Let me know if you need anything else.
