Good Morning David:

After our conference call on Friday I had to run off to a meeting and then was out-of-pocket during the afternoon. This A.M. I did follow-up with Roland (Real Estate VP) regarding his take on the call. We were both kind of confused as to where things were left. My notes indicate that they requested further comment/description on any salvage activities after abandonment, if any, and or any other plans we might have for the line and there affects to the structures, if any. Is this accurate? Basically we are expected to do one of two things: 1.) Pick-up the rail with no disturbance to the structures, for salvage; or, 2.) Sell the land outright to the State (or some other interested party). The conditions of the sale are obviously unknown at this time (i.e. with or without the rail, etc.).
