Dear US Fish & Wildlife Service:

Please be advised that on July 25, 2008, CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSXT) expects to file with the Surface Transportation Board (Board) a Notice of Exemption seeking authority to abandon 1.67 miles of railroad from Valuation Station 0+00 (near Railroad Milepost XXB 10) to Valuation Station 88+10, known as the AG Lead in College Park, Fulton and Clayton Counties, Georgia.

Attached is a preliminary Environmental Report describing the proposed action and any expected environmental effects. We are providing this report so that you may review the information that will form the basis for the Board's independent environmental analysis of this proceeding. Before this Report is finalized and submitted to the Board, we will incorporate into it any comments that we receive from you. 
