**NOTICE OF CONSUMMATION**

**RE: Abandonment of the 900 South Line from Milepost 780.1 near Redwood Road to Milepost 782.32, Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah;  
Docket No. AB-33 (Sub-No. 237X)**

Dear Secretary Quinlan:

This is to advise the Board that in accordance with 49 C.F.R. 1152.28(e)(2), Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UP") has exercised the authority granted by the Board in the Decisions served on June 2, 2006 and May 12, 2009, (the "Decisions"), in the above-referenced matter, and has as of this date consummated the abandonment of UP's 900 South Line (the "Line"). The Line extends from Milepost 780.1 to Milepost 782.32, a distance of 2.2 miles in Salt Lake County, Utah.

Regarding salvaging of the Line, UP's consultations with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Utah Department of Environmental Quality, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers resulted in no additional regulatory procedures than those utilized for the salvaging of the Line. As information, due in part to personnel changes resulting from retirements and position reassignments in both the UP Law Department and UP Engineering Department, consultations were not completed before the salvage activities took place. However, post-salvage consultations by UP with the above referenced Governmental Agencies confirmed that the Governmental Agencies had no additional regulatory concerns with regard to UP's salvage of the Line.
