RE: CSX Transportation, Inc. - Proposed Abandonment - STB Docket No. AB-55 (Sub No. 739X)

Please be advised that on or about May 22, 2015 CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSXT) is considering to file with the Surface Transportation Board (STB) a Notice of Exemption seeking authority to abandon service in the Southern Region, Atlanta Division, Atlanta Terminal Subdivision from Railroad Milepost ### 472.27 to ### 472.64. The distance is approximately 0.37 of a mile near Atlanta, Fulton County, Georgia as depicted on the attached map. Please note that the milepost markers and the total distance have been revised for STB Docket No. AB 55 (Sub-No. 739X) from the previous correspondence on April 13, 2015.

Attached is a preliminary Environmental Report describing the proposed action and includes information we have received from your agencies. We are providing this report so that you may review the information that will form the basis for the STB's independent environmental analysis of this proceeding. Before this Report is finalized and submitted to the STB, we will incorporate into it any comments that we receive from you. Your comments will be considered by the STB in evaluating the environmental impacts of the contemplated action.
