





RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE GREAT LAKES BASIN RAILROAD

WHEREAS, the LYNNVILLE-SCOTT-WHITE ROCK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, Ogle County, Illinois, is opposed to the Great Lakes Basin Rail and Utility Corridor Project (Surface Transportation Board, Docket #35952) for the following reasons:

- A. The proposed improvements will result in response time delay in providing fire, ambulance, and rescue services within the District.
- B. The voluminous crossings will certainly result in more accidents within the District.
- C. The improvements contemplated will certainly result in the transportation of more inherently dangerous cargo through the District.
- D. The contemplated high speed rail will certainly result in more derailments within the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the LYNNVILLE-SCOTT-WHITE ROCK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, Ogle County, Illinois, is opposed to the Great Lakes Basin Rail and Utility Corridor Project, which matter is pending before the Surface Transportation Board as Docket #35952;


