

Nancy Wallace:

She supports the idea of having more freight trains – and all trains. She is concerned with the Canadian National RR deal as it might occur at the expense of local taxpayers. She watched the widening of the tracks servicing her area but her hopes came to disappointment. She noted that CN came in and lessened service to the Antioch area. She resents the lowered service to and from Antioch particularly since she lives within walking distance of a station.

As an example there is no service to O'Hare on weekends and during rush hours. She complained about the existence of few express trains. She stated that the distance from Antioch to O'Hare about equals that of Evanston to ORD yet residents of most of Lake County need to call costly taxis to get there.

She pointed out that the semi-circle Elgin Line and Canadian line appears to go about 100 miles out its way to avoid Chicago. She suggested an extension of the CN line coming from the North. She posits that would save miles, time and fuel as it would be closer to the city. Her feeling is that these are lousy deals similar to the Antioch situation done at the expense and the inconvenience the resident taxpayer.
