We live approximately 1/4 mile from the Cuba Road crossing. Currently we are affected by both the noise and vibrations (occasionally) as well as driving delays while waiting for the trains to pass. Frequently enough the trains are stopped for significant periods of time.

Obviously, all of these issues will become substantially greater problems with the significant projected train traffic.

We also are frequently in downtown Barrington at the Main Street crossing. That is already a major traffic problem. The E&E tracks further up Hough Street will really worsen this situation.

Access to hospitals, speedy arrival of fire departments, moving hazardous materials through residential areas, planning evacuation routes in times of disaster - we all problems we worry about.
